

PEG-DHCP RFC2322-bis with IPv6

How to use the peg

Each peg has an IPv4 and IPv6 reserved.

Example your peg says: 151.216.10.50/23

Your IPv4 address is then 151.216.10.50/23

Your IPv6 address is then 2001:678:9ec:10::50/64

Wired SOUTH

The area including Food area, Noisy, Workshop rooms

Use the pegs with RED writing.

Your IPv4 address is on the PEG

Your IPv6 address is 2001:678:9ec:10::\$LAST_OCTET

Default gateways are 151.216.10.1/23 2001:678:9ec:10::1

Wired NORTH

The area including General camping, Caravan, Bar, Family

Use the pegs with BLUE writing.

Your IPv4 address is on the PEG

Your IPv6 address is 2001:678:9ec:8::\$LAST_OCTET

Default gateways are 151.216.8.1/23 2001:678:9ec:8::1
